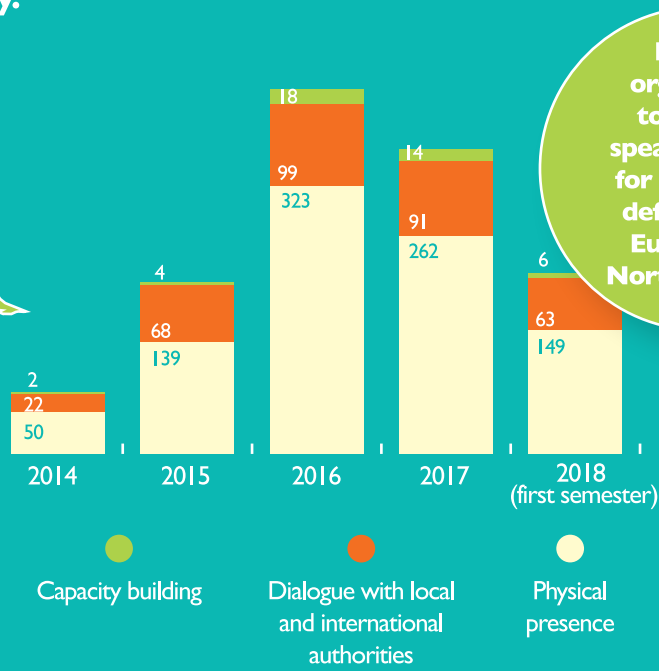
- Publication of a report on the situation of defenders for the 2015 UN Universal Periodic Review of Honduras

- Presence during university protests due to the criminalisation of UNAH students
- Presence in Costa Rica during the judgement of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights in the Case of López Lone v. Honduras

- Publication of the Workbook on Protection for Defenders
- Observation of university protests due to the criminalisation of UNAH students
- Start of accompaniment to Hedme Castro (ACI-Participa)
- Observation of protests during the post-electoral crisis

- Start of accompaniment to AJD, COPINH and Kevin Ramírez
- Publication of the report on defenders in Honduras prior to the periodic examination of Honduras by the UN Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights

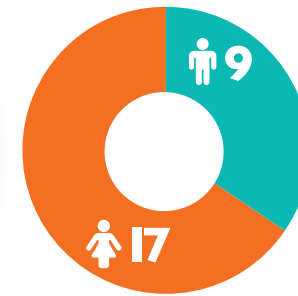
- Start of accompaniment to C-Libre, ASODEBICOQ and CNTC

PBI has organised a total of 17 speaking tours for Honduran defenders to Europe and North America

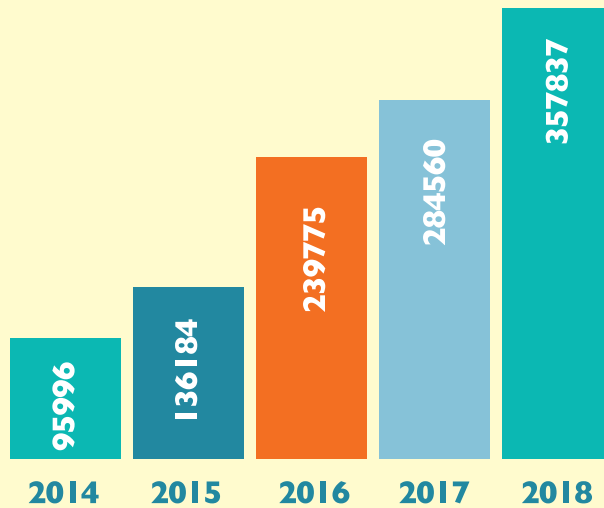

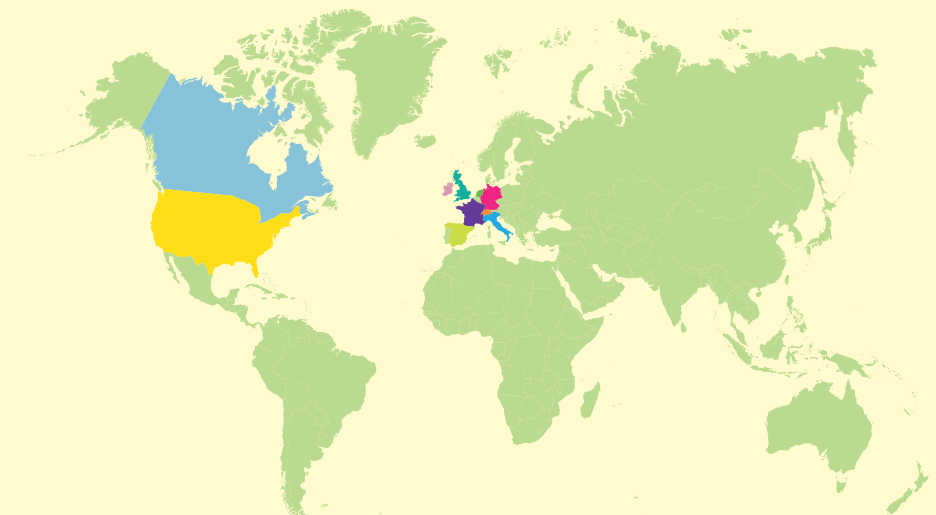
