Psychosocial care for the LGTB Association through healing tools from energy psychology and Mayan spirituality in a crisis and mourning situation (August 2019)



OTHERS:

Contribution to the Universal Periodic Review (UPR) on women ESCR defenders, the particular risks that they face, and the need for differential state protection (September 2019)

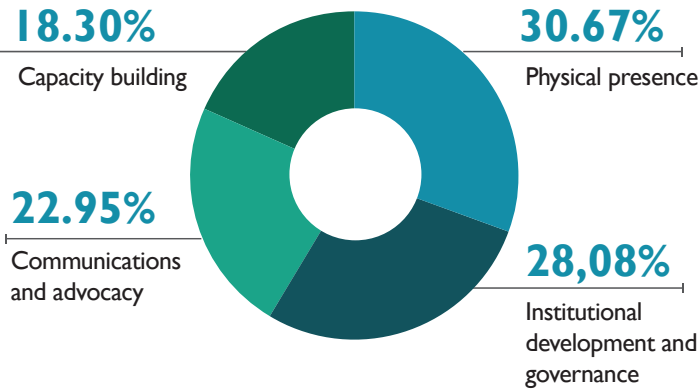

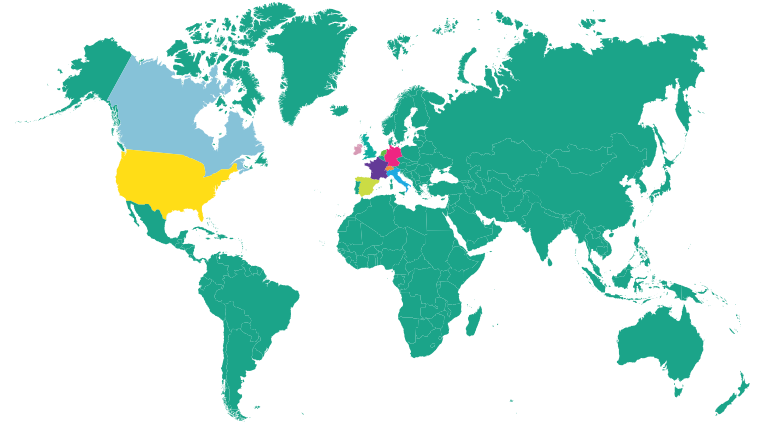


How do we use our funds?

Where do our funds come from?

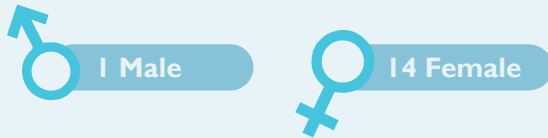
